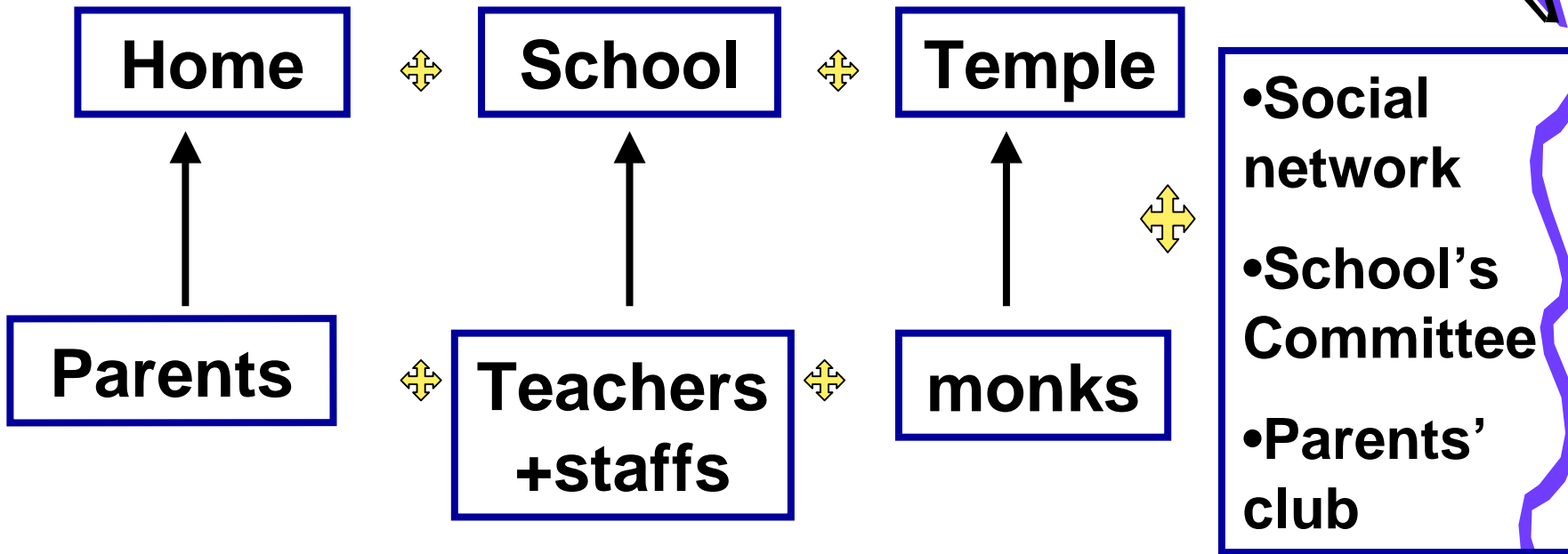
Big Problem



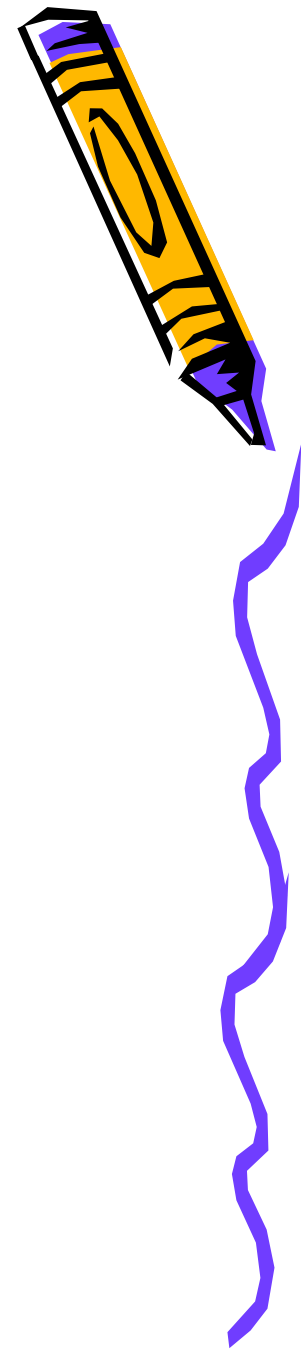
- The students who finish from the school can't study in the higher level or find a job

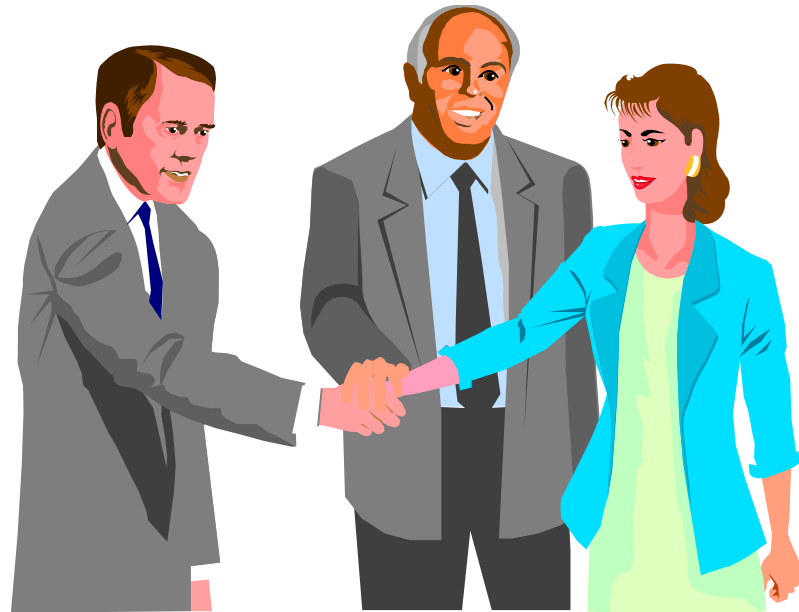
